The placement of 2977 American Flags will take place from 7:00AM to 7:00PM, Tuesday the 6th through Saturday the 10th. Each American Flag represents one of the victims of the 9-11 terrorist attacks that took place in New York City, Shanksville PA and the Pentagon in Washington D.C.

Flag Presenters: (First Responders, Fire Fighters, Police Officers, E.M.T.'s), (Service Club Members), (County, City, & Township Officials, Community Leaders), (Veterans & Armed Force Personnel that are currently serving), (Students & Educators)

Flag Presenters Role: The Flag Presenters will greet the participants from our community as they arrive to place an American Flag in Remembrance. They will hand them an American Flag and show them where to place it in the front lawn area. Presenters will present a Patriot Day Certificate to the participant that will include the the participants name and the name of one of the 9-11 victims. All Flag Presenters will receive a lapel Pin depicting the twin towers with the inscription, "Always in our Memory".

Participants Role: Participants will be invited to receive an American Flag and a Patriot Day Certificate from the Flag Presenter. The American Flag will be placed in the front lawn area in remembrance of one of the 9-11 victims. The Patriot Day Certificate will bear the name of the person who puts the flag in the ground as well as one of the victims of the 9-11 terrorist attack.
